

## Cookie Policy

### What is a Cookie?

A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed/installed on your computer's main storage drive (hard drive). Once you agree, the file is added, and the cookie helps analyse web traffic or lets you know when you visit a particular site. Cookies allow web applications to respond to you as an individual.

Cookies help us provide you with a better website by enabling us to monitor the pages that you as the user find useful and tailor our website to your needs, likes and dislikes by gathering and remembering information about your preferences.

### What do we use Cookie information for?

Kapwealth uses traffic log cookies to identify which pages are being used. This helps us analyse data about web page traffic and improve our website in order to tailor it to your needs. We only use this information for statistical analysis purposes and then the data is removed from the system.

Kapwealth may collect information about your computer, including where available your IP address, operating system and browser type, for system administration. This is statistical data about your browsing actions and patterns and does not identify you or anyone else as an individual.

A cookie in no way gives us access to your computer or any personal information about you, other than the data which you choose to share with us.

We comply with the recent UK and EU law on handling cookies. You can choose to accept or decline cookies when you use our website. Most modern web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser settings to decline cookies if you prefer.
